1.	<p><u>1.1 Call for start of rally</u> The Returning Officer, Ms Nurfatin Binte Azni, called for a start to the rally at 1030hrs.</p> <p><u>1.2 Proposal for the rally to proceed</u> Proposer: Mr Ang Hao Yuan (U1860079A) Seconder: Mr Toh Kai Wei Clarence (U1860125C)</p> <p><u>1.2.1 Returning Officer's Address</u> In her capacity as the Returning Officer of the 28th TTC Management Committee Elections, Ms Nurfatin Binte Azni began her Returning Officer's Address. She outlined the rationale for the Election Rally. She highlighted that every candidate would have at least 5 minutes of rally speech and 5 minutes of question and answer. Candidates running for the roles of the President, Vice President, Honorary General Secretary and Honorary Financial Controller would have 15 minutes for their rally speech and 15 minutes of question and answer. In the event that there is a proposed extension of the time to speak or ask questions, it will be subjected to approval.</p> <p>All rally recordings/minutes will be submitted within 24 hours to the UEC. These records will be kept for at least 3 years for the auditing by the university administrator and the law of the Republic of Singapore.</p>	
2	<p><u>2.1 President Candidate: Goh Cheng Ze</u></p> <p>Proposer: Mr Toh Jopescu (U1660166K) Seconder: Mr Marcus Lau Shao Yu (U1860147D)</p> <p>Mr Goh Cheng Ze began with an introduction of his current field of study and his personal interests in cooking and exercise. He also shared that he is an alumnus of Tampines Junior College (TPJC) and that he was the Head of Operations for two years in the TPJC student council. He is the current Manpower Officer for the 28th Trainee Teachers' Club (TTC).</p> <p>Mr Goh elaborates that he was also the Chairperson of the AY 19/20 Orientation Planning and Management Committee (OPMC) and had a big stake in the execution and planning of the Freshmen Orientation Programme. During his term as the Chairperson of the OPMC, he discovered his passion for events planning and management.</p> <p>Mr Goh states that he is running for President in order to represent the interests of the NIE student body as well as her unique collective</p>	

<p>identity. He also seeks this as a platform to stand for more opportunities to collectively foster a student identity. He cites the revival of events such as the T-shirt design competition to enable student teachers in NIE to have access to merchandise created 'by teachers, for teachers'.</p> <p>Mr Goh also outlined a timeline of mainstay events for the current academic year such as the various Welfare events and other events organized by the TTC subsidiary clubs, such as the Current Events Forum organized by Deixus and the Mid-Autumn Festival organised by the Chinese Language Education and Research Club. He hopes to continue to plan events that are inclusive and representative of the NIE community's needs if he is elected.</p> <p>Mr Goh is running his platform on the values of representation, welfare, and community. He also expressed his desire to represent the NIE community at the larger NTU level through the TTC he also expressed his commitment to further the interests and concerns of student welfare and plan for activities that promote a healthier work-life balance in NIE.</p> <p>He seeks to be the bridge and link that connects every NIE student teacher together and also be the bridge that links the NIE student body with the Office of Teacher Education.</p> <p>Mr Goh ends his rally speech by citing John F. Kennedy: "Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country." In the same vein, he hopes that the NIE student body will take this opportunity to have a stake in the future and direction of its student democracy. He concludes that a vote for him is a vote for representation, welfare, and community.</p> <p><u>2.2 Questions and Answers</u> Mr Toh Kai Wei, Clarence (U1860125C)</p> <p><u>2.2.1 There are members of the student body who are not in any NIE sub-clubs. How can you cater to the needs of these students and how would you include them in student life? How can this welfare be extended to them past welfare packs?</u></p> <p>Mr Goh cited the need to adapt with the times and change the previous welfare pack events to welfare-oriented events like last academic year's Hygge event due to new NTU guidelines on wastage. He plans to work closely with welfare officers to brainstorm and provide for the</p>

<p>community through items like encouragement boards and other such concepts. He acknowledges that it is impossible to 'force' everyone to participate in sub-club events but that word-of-mouth helps in bringing people on board to participate in events and that this strategy is first contingent on a bonded NIE community.</p> <p>Mr Ryan Lim Xing Yan (U1760085B)</p> <p><u>2.2.2 I noticed most of the committee members-elect are Year 2s. considering semester exchange and international practicum, how are you going to ensure the committee continues to function?</u></p> <p>Mr Goh elaborated that two members are going away this coming December for a service-learning trip and that this absence of members who are overseas on school trips is a perennial expectation. Mr Goh notes that this proposed committee is larger than the outgoing exco and that a significant number are Y1 student teachers and thus, this will not be too big an issue compared to previous years. Mr Goh notes the importance and his dedication to early and thorough planning to alleviate the issue. He will also seek inspiration in his predecessors.</p> <p>Mr Seow Shien Ern Jeremiah (U1660171B)</p> <p><u>2.2.3 I noticed that 3 out of the top 4 will be heading overseas for semester exchange/international practicum. How would you plan and lead in this scenario? How do we ensure line of succession – a problem that persists every year – is also addressed?</u></p> <p>Mr Goh notes that it is imperative to have sufficient dialogue between all committee members. Another way to counter such issues is to involve more active participation from the Year 1s (including those not in the exco) as it nears IP period like for grad night and FOP.</p> <p>Mr Goh notes that as early as January there were talks of succession planning and that a lot of it is getting to the crux of a person's character by uncovering what one's vision, goal of TTC is and what portfolio suits them. It is not merely about objective but also about what a person's attitude and aptitude are. Line of succession planning has also been done earlier than previous practice. There are steps in place to guide incoming TTC exco members. For instance, each portfolio has term of reference document and that each incoming member will receive one.</p> <p>He also notes that succession issues are perennial issues and that he will look to his predecessors for advice.
