

Miscellaneous Regulations

Interpretation

1. In this Regulation, unless it is otherwise provided or the context otherwise requires, all words shall have the meanings given in the Constitution of the Nanyang Technological University Students' Union.

Amendment

2. A Motion seeking to amend or remove any provision of this Regulation shall not be passed unless it has been supported by the votes of:
 - (1) Not less than half of the total number of Voting Council Representatives present during a Council Meeting, or
 - (2) Not less than half of the total numbers of Union Members present during a General Meeting of the Union.
3. For the purposes of section 2, amendment of provisions includes addition, amendment or repealing of provisions.

Legislative History

4. This legislation was first enacted on 3 March 2017.

Resignations

5. Any member of the Council or the Executive Committee resigning from his office shall tender his resignation in writing and shall not be deemed to have resigned until his resignation is accepted, in accordance with Article XIV of the Constitution.
 - (1) This shall apply to Council Representatives, Executive Committee Representatives, co-opted members of the Council and co-opted members of the Executive Committee.
6. Resignations shall be sent to the Honorary General Secretary for acceptance by the Council.
 - (1) The resignation of any member of Council Standing Committees, other than the Executive Committee, shall be sent to the Chairman of the Executive Committee for his acceptance through the Secretary of the Committee concerned. If the resignation is accepted, the Executive Committee shall then proceed with the appointment of a new member.
7. When the resignation of a Council Representative has been accepted, he shall be deemed to have resigned from his capacity as a Council Representative. Nothing shall preclude him from continuing on in his capacity as a member of his Constituent Club's Management Committee.
 - (1) In the event of a Council Representative ceases to be a member of his Constituent Club's Management Committee, he shall also cease to be a Council Representative.
8. When the resignation of an Executive Committee Representative has been accepted, he shall be deemed to have resigned from both his office in the Executive Committee and his capacity as an Executive Committee Representative of his Constituent Club.
9. When the resignation of a member of a Council Standing Committee, other than the Executive Committee, is accepted by the Chairman of the Executive Committee, he shall be deemed to have only resigned from his capacity as a member of the Council Standing Committee. His capacity as a Council Representative shall not be affected by such resignation.

Vacancies

10. The respective Constituent Club's Management Committee shall have the discretion to decide on whether to fill a vacancy arising under sections 8, 9 or 10.
 - (1) Such discretion, if exercised, shall be exercised within four (4) weeks of the vacancy arising.
 - (2) If the Management Committee decides not to fill the vacancy, or does not make a decision on filling the vacancy, within the time period stated in subsection (1), the vacancy shall remain unfilled for the rest of the term.

- (3) If the Management Committee decides to fill the vacancy within the time period stated in subsection (1), the vacancy shall be filled within four (4) weeks of the decision.
- (4) The time periods stated in subsections (1) and (3) shall not include vacation periods.
- 11. A vacancy on the Council arising from the resignation, removal, incapacity, unavailability or any other causes of a Council Representative shall only be filled by way of an election among the members of that Constituent Club's Management Committee.
- 12. A vacancy on any Constituent Club's Management Committee arising from the resignation, removal, incapacity, unavailability or any other causes of an elected member of the Management Committee shall only be filled by way of the mechanism specified in that Constituent Club's Constitution, its regulations or any of its other written laws.
- 13. A vacancy on the Council arising from the resignation, removal, incapacity, unavailability or any other causes of an Executive Committee Representative shall only be filled by way of a by-election held by that Constituent Club in accordance with the Executive Committee Elections Regulations.
- 14. A vacancy arising from the resignation, removal, incapacity, unavailability or any other causes of a member on a Council Standing Committee, other than the Executive Committee, shall be filled in a manner deemed by the Council to be appropriate to the vacancy.

Dissolution

- 15. In the event that the Union being dissolved, all debts and liabilities legally incurred on behalf of the Union shall be fully discharged, and the remaining funds will be donated to the University.
